

RULES & REGULATIONS GOVERNING R + L CARRIERS DOUBLES CLASSIC

- Rule 1. This ***Mixed Doubles Event, consisting of one male and one female bowler***, will be open to all members of the United States Bowling Congress and will be conducted in accordance with rules of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) in addition to rules adopted by the N O USBC BA and the N O USBC WBA Associations. The adopted rules must not be in conflict with USBC rules. **Rules 319a 2 and 319c through 319e WILL NOT APPLY TO THIS TOURNAMENT.**
- Members of other Associations may bowl in this tournament and LOCAL ASSOCIATION DUES WILL BE WAIVED. All members are required to have their membership cards. Non-members must apply for an associate membership by paying fee of \$20.00.
- Rule 2. **HANDICAP** – 90% of the difference between team average and 440.
- Rule 3. A bowlers ***highest USBC sanctioned standard league average*** will be used to calculate all handicaps. **NO SPORT AVERAGE WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Highest 2009-2010 Book Average twenty-one (21) or more games in one league; if no book average, then highest 2009-2010 Winter League average of 21 games or more in one league; if no winter league average, then highest 2010 Summer League Average of 21 games or more in one league. If none of the above, entrant may bowl scratch 220.
- Rule 4. Multiple participation is allowed but bowler can only cash once with same partner. **Re-entries only** will be accepted at the tournament site if lanes are available and **re-entry fee must be paid in cash. NO WALK-INS ALLOWED.**
- Rule 5. Included in the \$35 Entry Fee is \$10 for which participant will receive a ticket to the New Orleans Bowl being held December 18, 2010 at the New Orleans Superdome.
- Rule 6. **Bowler arriving late, will be allowed to start in the frame in progress. Bowler will not be credited with any pins for the frames missed.**
- Rule 7. NO PACERS ARE ALLOWED.
- Rule 8. **Protests - Rule 329.** Protests involving eligibility or playing rules must be made to tournament management in writing within the time limits in Rule 329. The decision of tournament management will be final unless a written appeal is filed with USBC Headquarters within the time limits in Rule 329.
- Rule 9. **Prize Fee will be returned 100%.** Prize money will be paid in a ratio of one (1) in eight (8) to handicap winners.
- Rule 10. **Entries close October 1, 2010.**
