BOWLERS MAY PARTICIPATE ON A TOTAL OF THREE TEAMS PROVIDED NOT MORE THAN 2 BOWLERS BOWL TOGETHER ON THE OTHER TEAMS.

BOWLER MAY PARTICIPATE IN DOUBLES & SINGLES EVENTS TWICE BUT NOT WITH THE SAME DOUBLES PARTNER. YOU CAN CASH TWICE IN DOUBLES BUT ONLY ONCE IN SINGLES EVENT.

RULES & REGULATIONS GOVERNING N O USBC WBA ANNUAL TOURNAMENT

1. **Only members of the New Orleans USBC WBA may bowl in this tournament.**
2. **Bowlers may participate with three (3) teams, provided not more than (2) bowlers on a 4 Member Team bowl together on the other teams.**
Bowlers may participate in Doubles & Singles twice but with a different Doubles Partner. You can cash only once in Singles Event.
3. **FIRST TEAM AND FIRST DOUBLES & SINGLES EVENTS TO COUNT TOWARD ALL-EVENTS SCORE.**
4. Highest 2010-2011 book average; if no book average, then highest final winter 2010-2011 average of 21 games or more; if no winter average, highest 2011 summer average of 21 games or more; if none of the above, highest current average of at least 21 games as of Oct. 28, 2011. If none of the above entrant may bowl scratch (225).
5. **HANDICAP** -- 90% of difference between player's average and 225.
6. **HIGHEST ALL EVENTS TOTAL DENOTES CITY CHAMPION(S).**
HIGHEST ALL EVENTS SCRATCH TOTAL DENOTES SCRATCH CITY CHAMPION(S).
7. **Bowlers arriving late, will be allowed to start in the frame in progress. No score will be given for frames missed.**
8. Competition among entrants in an event, with the exception of all events, shall be held in the same establishment. In case of ties in first place in any event, those scoring such ties shall be declared co-champions for the particular event. When ties for any place occur, the prize money will be combined and divided equally among the tied position winners.
9. Substitutes are allowed when replacement is necessary. The Association Manager must be advised of substitutions at least one hour before the scheduled bowling time, if possible. In case of an emergency after a game has started a substitute, if one is available, shall be allowed in the team and doubles events only. The combined scores are to count in either of these events. If no substitute is available, only the actual score of the frames bowled shall count.
10. **A substitute is not required to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee paid, nor shall the substitute be expected to give the original entrant any prize money she may win.**
11. The lineup will be the same as shown on the entry form.
12. **Captains must check their teams in at least 1/2 hour before scheduled time.**
13. Bowlers entering the doubles event must also enter the singles event and vice versa, all 6 games to be bowled on the same pair of scheduled lanes.
14. Lanes will be assigned by the tournament committee.
15. Entries will be scheduled according to request if possible and in the order received.
16. **PROTEST:** Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing and filed with the tournament manager within 72 hours of the infraction or prior to the payment of tournament prizes, whichever occurs first. See USBC Rule 329 for additional information and requirements. Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament manager within 24 hours after the game has been played.
17. The Tournament Committee of the New Orleans USBC WBA shall decide any question not covered by these tournament rules and has the power to hear and act on all protests.
18. **TOURNAMENT RULES:** The tournament shall be conducted in accordance with the USBC rules governing local association tournaments and the USBC general playing rules, in addition to the rules adopted by the association. The adopted rules must not conflict with USBC rules. **RULES 319a 2 and 319c through 319e WILL NOT APPLY TO THIS TOURNAMENT.**
19. **ENTRIES RECEIVED OR POSTMARKED AFTER OCTOBER 28, 2011 WILL HAVE AN ADDITIONAL \$5 PER PERSON PER ENTRY ADDED TO THE COST OF THE ENTRY FEE. WALK-IN ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED BASED ON LANE AVAILABILITY AND ENTRY FEES TO BE PAID IN CASH ONLY.**
20. Averages will be rechecked before prize money is distributed.
21. **Prize money will be paid in a ratio of one (1) in six (6) for Teams, Doubles & Singles Events.**
22. Fees for Optional All Events Scratch and/or Handicap are **not transferrable unless substitute replaces original bowler in all 3 events prior to first event.** Prize money for All Events will be paid in a ratio of one (1) in fifteen (15).
